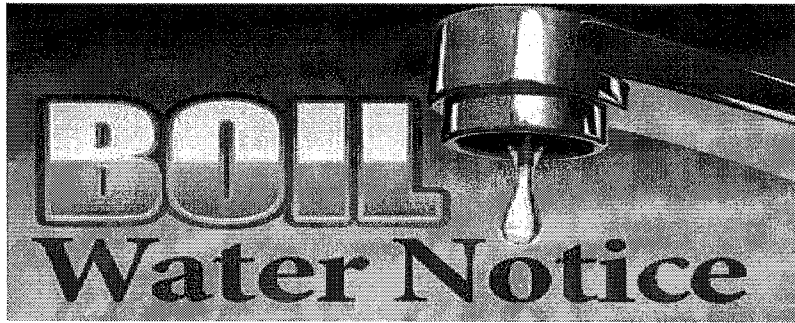

Due to a broken valve being replaced, causing a drop in the water pressure below 0 PSI, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system for the CITY OF WELLS

ID# 0370004 to notify customers of the need to boil their water before consumption.

The only structures affected by this water line break are listed:

All customers living on Booker Street.

To ensure the destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled before use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.

On **November 28, 2023**, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) required our public water system, **CITY OF WELLS ID# 0370004**, to issue a Boil Water Notice (BWN) to inform our customers that **due to a broken valve being replaced, causing a drop in the water pressure below 0 PSI**, causing a interruption in service, water from our system must be boiled prior to consumption.

Our system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore adequate pressure, disinfectant levels, and bacteriological quality and has provided TCEQ with testing results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling as of **November 30, 2023**.
