

Public Notice to Boil Water

May 2, 2023

Due to <u>A WATER VALVE BREAK ON THE MAIN LINE</u>, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system for the CITY OF WELLS ID# 0370004 to notify customers of the need to boil their water before consumption.

The only structures effective by this water line break are listed below: All Customers on the City of Wells Utility System that live on the following city streets.

E 6th St., E 7th St., Bonita St, County Road 2631, and County Road 2632.

To ensure the destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled before use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.

Alert from City of Wells: Boil Water Notice Canceled

Date: May 04, 2023

On May 2, 2023, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) required our public water system, CITY OF WELLS ID# 0370004, to issue a Boil Water Notice (BWN) to inform our customers that due to the elevated tank freezing causing a city-wide interruption in service, water from our system must be boiled prior to consumption.

Location: All Customers on the City of Wells Utility System that live on the following city streets.

E 6th St., E 7th St., Bonita St, County Road 2631, and County Road 2632.

Our system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore adequate pressure, disinfectant levels, and bacteriological quality and has provided TCEQ with testing results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling as of **May 4, 2023.**
