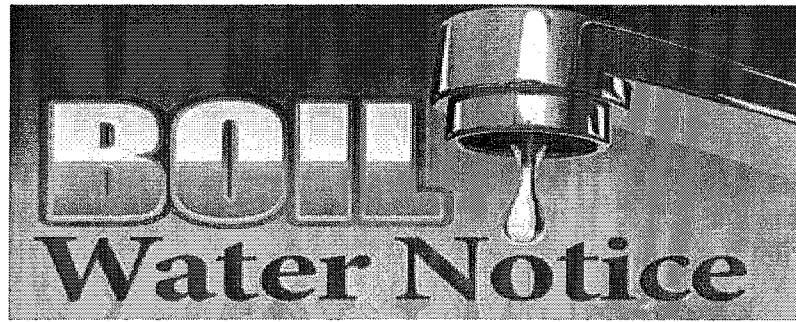

Public Notice to Boil Water

February 15, 2021

Due to PLANT FREEZE DUE TO WEATHER, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system LAKESIDE WATER SUPPLY ID# 0030104 to notify customers of the need to boil their water before consumption.

The only structures effective by this water line break are listed below:

300-900 Block of Rusk Ave (Highway 69 from the post office to the North city limits), Forest Rd, Booker St, Warren Rd, Preston Rd, W Frank Edge, W Oldham, Wright Patman Dr, E Greenville Rd, E Oldham, E Frank Edge, Warner Rd (aka CR 2626), E 1st St., May St, E 2nd St.

To ensure the destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled before use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.

Cancelled Notice

On **May 8, 2021**, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) required our public water system, **CITY OF WELLS ID# 0370004** to issue a Boil Water Notice (BWN) to inform our customers that due to a line break causing an interruption in service, water from our system must be boiled prior to consumption.

Location: 300-900 Block of Rusk Ave (Highway 69 from the post office to the North city limits), Forest Rd, Booker St, Warren Rd, Preston Rd, W Frank Edge, W Oldham, Wright Patman Dr, E Greenville Rd, E Oldham, E Frank Edge, Warner Rd (aka CR 2626), E 1st St., May St, E 2nd St.

Our system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore adequate pressure, disinfectant levels, and bacteriological quality and has provided TCEQ with testing results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling as of **May 21, 2021**.
