PUBLIC NOTICE FAILURE TO SUBMIT A DISINFECTANT QUARTERLY OPERATING REPORT (DLQOR) MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE

The City of Wells Water System PWS ID 0370004 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred during the monitoring periods of **April 2022 – June 2022.**

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: Submit reports by the quarterly due date, which is the 10th day of the month following the end of the quarter. Verify that the online submission is processed correctly and that TCEQ received the report.

The report required by TCEQ was processed on the STEERS website on August 3, 2022; our team member inevitably failed to process the paperwork online due to contracting COVID on July 1, 2022. The DLQOR passed the submission that was made on August 3, 2022, and all samples for the quarter were collected and sent to the lab in a timely manner for the quarter listed above.
